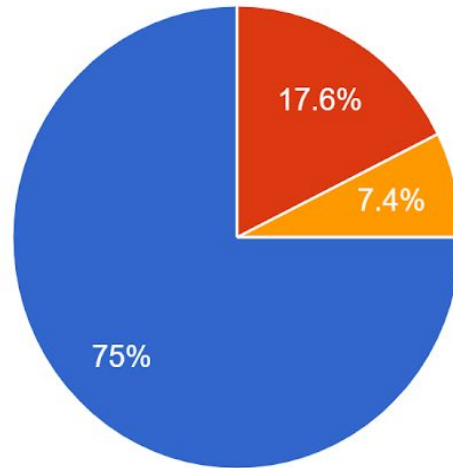


What reopening plan works best for your family?

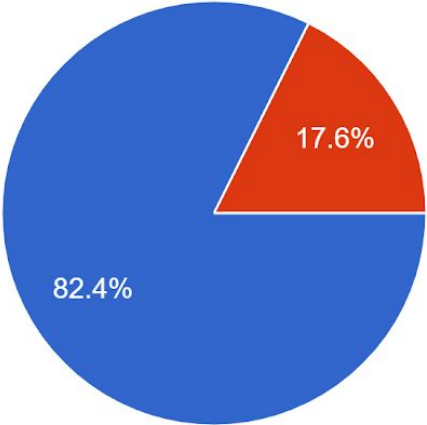

If Scotia School is able to resume 5 days/week on-campus learning on August 31, your child(ren) will

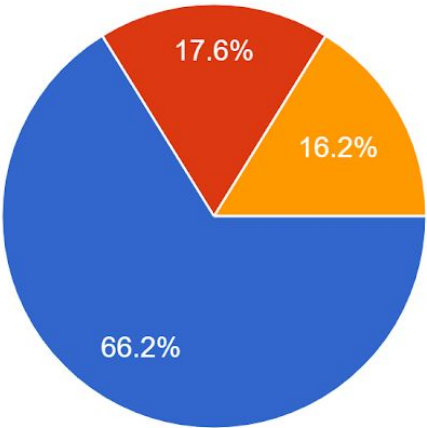

While Scotia School plans to safely reopen to all students on August 31, if we are unable to do so, which scenario works best for your family?

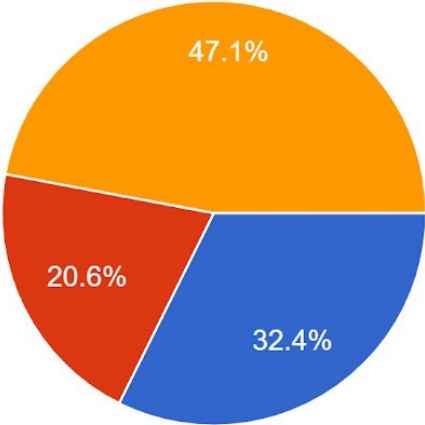

We have added a free supper program to our After School Program for 2020-2021! Do you plan to utilize our After School Program, which will also have safety measures in place?

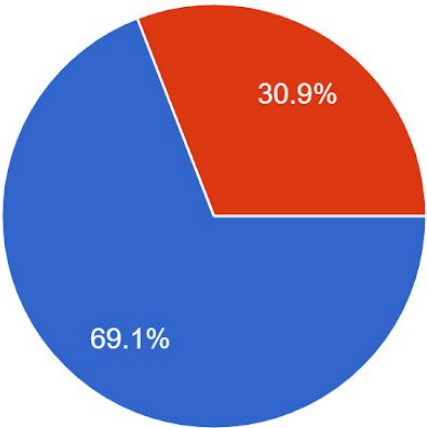
