The last day of school is Thursday, June 13, but we are planning for next year! If you have a 4 or 5 year old, ! Miss Knudsen's Transitional Kindergarten class is for students who are 4 on the first day of school, and Mrs. Vevoda's Kindergarten class is for students who are 5 on the first day of school . Please call the school or stop by to pick up a TK/K registration packet, and ask any questions.

Expanded Learning Opportunities After School Program (ASES) paperwork for next year is available from Mrs. Lisa at ASES or from the office.

Our summer expanded learning opportunities program is offered to students in TK-6 grades. Our summer offerings include: Camp Scotia July 15-18 and July 22-25, Mid Summer Fun with our ASES staff July 29-August 1, Jump Start and ASES afternoons August 5-8 and August 12-15. All weeks will be Monday through Thursday, 7:00-4:00. The cafeteria will be open each morning at 7:00, and breakfast will be served at 8:00. After care with our ASES staff will be available until 4:00 each day. We are also going on Friday Field Trips July 19 and 26, and August 2 and 9!

Sign up forms for our summer programs were sent home in May. If you still need to register your child(ren) in Scotia School summer programs, please submit the registration form or contact your child's teacher for another copy.

Incoming 7th graders MUST have proof of Tdap and 2 Varicella immunizations, and all other immunizations must be up to date, prior to the first day of 7th grade. Any seventh graders without proof of updated vaccinations, including Tdap and 2 Varicella doses, will NOT be able to attend school, and will be sent home. Immunization information will be sent home with report cards on the last day of school.

Incoming Kindergarteners and Transitional Kindergarteners MUST have proof of completion of all required immunizations prior to registering. Please provide proof of immunizations prior to first day of school. You can drop off paperwork at the office in June or August, mail it to P.O. Box 217, email it to twalsh@scotiaschool.org, or fax it to 764-5111.

If you need help creating an account in Schoolwise, please call your child's teacher or the office and we will help you get registered.

PTO will again be sponsoring our last day of school "Lunch on the Lawn" on June 13. Please plan to join your students beginning at noon on the field for barbecue lunch!
