<u>Planning for next year is underway!</u> If your child(ren) will not be attending Scotia School in the fall, please contact the office. If you live outside of the Scotia School District, you must have a completed Interdistrict Transfer Agreement completed.

<u>Transitional Kindergarten/Kindergarten Registration is in full swing!</u> To meet the age requirements for kindergarten, a child must be 5 by the first day of school. For transitional kindergarten, a child must be 4 by the first day of school. Kindergarten and transitional kindergarten registration paperwork is available in the office.

If you have forgotten your Schoolwise login information, or if you have any questions about CAASPP testing or signing up on Schoolwise, please contact your child's teacher.
