Parking around the school is limited, and there is currently no visitor parking available in the lower area in front of the staff parking lot. Please park going down Church Street, or on 1st street at the end closest to B Street. The front parking lot is for staff use only. Thank you for helping to keep our students safe!

Upon arrival at school each morning, students are to go straight to the cafeteria, where there is adult supervision, and where they can enjoy breakfast, before being excused to their classrooms at 8:20.
