

TK/K Reading Logs

In TK/Kindergarten, students participate in a reading program throughout the school year to help promote life long reading. As a way to introduce the reading process to early readers, students listen to stories read by adults and use illustrations in books to create their own story or retell one. To help your student instill a love for reading, it is important to read to them as much as possible.



- As part of your child's weekly homework assignment, all students are asked to listen to **at least 4 or 5 books per week (one book a night)** with an adult and record them on the provided Reading Log form.
- Students may read/listen to the same book more than once.
- **Reading Logs will be due on Fridays.**
